

Reviewing the Background Check Results of Individuals Applying to Visit and/or Volunteer in an Ankeny Community School District Facility and/or with an Ankeny Community School District Activity

The Superintendent/designee shall use this framework to evaluate whether an individual applying to volunteer for the District with a past criminal conviction should be disqualified, on the basis of that conviction alone, from being approved as a volunteer. The Superintendent/designee retains discretion to deviate from this framework in keeping with law and policy to ensure the safety and well-being of the school community.
