

# CENTENNIAL CHEERLEADING UNIFORM AGREEMENT

## UNIFORM CARE:

- Each garment should be washed by itself in a full tub of **warm** or **cold** water (**see garment label for water temperature**) using the Permanent Press cycle.
- Use a mild detergent, **without** fabric softener. Tide is recommended. **DO NOT USE BLEACH!**
- Hand washing the garment is strongly advised.
- If the washing instructions are not followed, the colors may bleed onto one another. If this happens, wash the garment AGAIN (before drying), following the instructions above.
- **ALWAYS remove the garment promptly from the washer once the cycle is completed.**
  - o Leaving the garment in the washer for prolonged periods of time can cause the fabrics to bleed and/or leave unsightly wrinkles in the garment.
- **DO NOT machine dry the uniform.**
  - o Once the uniform has been washed, immediately hang it up to dry.
- **DO NOT dry clean the uniform.**
  - o Dry cleaning can yellow the uniform or leave an unsightly sheen. Dry cleaning also causes tackle twill lettering to fade, bubble, or stiffen.
- **Never use fabric softener or stain removers.**
  - o Fabric softeners block the soil release properties and can cause dirt and stains to resist removal. If a fabric softener is used, follow the original washing instructions.
  - o **Do not use a stain remover** (tide to-go stick or other “stain removing solution”). Stain removers may lock the stain into the garment. Instead just use regular detergent and a tooth brush to remove stain.
- **Consume ONLY water**
  - With the exception of school lunch on game days.
  - Be cautious of what you are eating/doing in your uniform to avoid stains. Stains made on the uniform may result in cheerleader individually paying for a new uniform piece.

## UNIFORM CARE AGGREEMENT:

- Any alterations to uniform MUST be completed through Coach Howlett when uniforms are distributed. Any alterations or mending of uniform during the season must also be completed or cleared through Coach Howlett. **CUTTING OF ANY UNIFORM MATERIAL IS PROHIBITED** and you will be charged to replace the uniform.
  - The assigned uniform(s) will be returned to coach in the same condition as when it was lent out. It will be cleaned, dry, in a plastic bag labeled with your name on it.
  - If uniform is returned stained or damaged, the cheerleader will be charged for the replacement or repair.
  - If uniform is lost and not returned, the cheerleader will be charged to replace the uniform.
    - Shell = ~\$130      Skirt = ~\$80      Sleeves = ~\$60
- \* Prices may vary based on year of purchase and style of uniform*
