CAP AND GOWNS will be distributed on Monday, May 10, from 10:55 a.m. – 1:05 p.m. in the Café Jag. Students should wear their cap and gown at both Senior Spotlight and the commencement ceremony. Appropriate clothing should be worn under the gowns.

SENIOR SPOTLIGHT NIGHT is scheduled for Tuesday, May 25, at 7:00 p.m. in the Main Gym. This night is to recognize seniors who are receiving awards and/or scholarships. Honorees will be notified by invitation.

We ask that the guests refrain from using noisemakers and from shouting or applauding during the ceremony. We will honor all graduates at the end of the diploma presentation. Graduates are expected to conduct themselves with dignity and respect during the ceremony.*
